The Byron Nelson Award

The Byron Nelson Award is given by the PGA TOUR and is based on each player's adjusted scoring average. The adjusted score is computed from the average score of the field at each tournament. As a result, a player's score may be higher or lower than his actual score. Actual scoring average was used to determine the scoring leader prior to 1988.

In order to qualify for the Byron Nelson Award, a player must compete in a minimum of 50 official rounds on the PGA TOUR.

Biggest 54 Hole Leads

The EDS Byron Nelson Championship is well known for its close competitions, often decided by the final shot of regulation play or by a playoff.

Miller Barber, who withstood a furious late charge by Kermit Zarley in 1968, enjoyed the greatest lead of the Nelson tournaments played thus far when he went into the final round leading by five strokes. Mac O'Grady, who had a three-stroke lead in the 1985 tournament, had the biggest lead of a non-winner.
